

TALK THE TALK

The nearby computer contains an interactive digital project you can play called *Talk the Talk*.

It is the result of a live project Chris did at a large number of venues, including the art gallery White-Flag Projects in St. Louis, the town of Carbondale, Illinois, a performance art show at Grace Space in upstate New York, the Museum of the Earth, the New York State Fair, a PreKindergarten class in Syracuse, and the Redhouse art gallery in Syracuse.

Chris showed the participants pictures of a number of dinosaurs and asked them to choose one, then asked them to make the noise they thought that dinosaur would have made.

The resulting digital project shows photographs of all those people while they were making their dinosaur sounds. If you run the mouse over their picture, you can hear them make their sounds!

The point of this project is, like *Walk the Walk*, to have a physical, experiential relationship with the concept of dinosaurs. Walking or talking like a dinosaur is the best way to help people get into the mindset of a dinosaur.

And, of course, it's pretty fun to hear people make dinosaur sounds--try it yourself!
